**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ENERGY FACILITY SITING BOARD.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 69H of chapter 164 of the General Laws is hereby fur-  
2 ther amended by striking out the second paragraph and inserting  
3 in place thereof the following two paragraphs:—

4 The board shall be composed of the chairman of the depart-  
5 ment, the secretary of environmental affairs, the secretary of eco-  
6 nomic affairs, or their respective designees, and six members to  
7 be appointed as follows:— one of whom shall be representative  
8 of organized labor appointed by the governor from a list of five  
9 names submitted by the Massachusetts State Labor Council,  
10 Building Trades Council, for a term of three years; two of whom  
11 shall be appointed by the governor from a list of five names sub-  
12 mitted by the Massachusetts Municipal Association and shall rep-  
13 resent the region in which the proposed facility is to be located;  
14 provided that there shall be six regions for the purposes of this  
15 section which shall consist of western, central, northeastern,  
16 southeastern, greater Boston, and Cape Cod; and three members  
17 to be appointed by the governor, each of whom shall be from  
18 statewide organizations concerned with consumer matters, protec-  
19 tion of the environment, and public health respectively.

20 The public members shall serve on a part-time basis, receive  
21 one hundred dollars per diem of board service, and be reimbursed  
22 by the commonwealth for all reasonable expenses actually and  
23 necessarily incurred in the performance of official board duties.

24 Upon the resignation of any public member, a successor shall  
25 be appointed in a like manner for the unexpired portion of the  
term. No person shall be appointed to serve more than two con-  
secutive full terms.
