AN ACT ESTABLISHING TEACHER CERTIFICATION FEES.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 38G of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most  
2 recently amended by section 26 of chapter 495 of the acts of 1993,  
3 is further amended by striking out the paragraph 25 of said sec-  
4 tion 38G and inserting in place thereof the following  
5 paragraph: —

6 All applications for a provisional educator certificate, a provi-  
7 sional educator certificate with advanced standing, and a standard  
8 certificate shall be accompanied by a fee to be determined annu-  
9 ally by the commissioner of administration under the provisions  
10 of section three B of chapter seven. Said fees shall be established  
11 and limited to allow the department to carry out the certification  
12 responsibilities, but in no case shall said application fees exceed  
13 one hundred dollars per year with an annual increase no greater  
14 than the consumer price index.
