## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

AN ACT REDUCING THE AGE OF ELIGIBILITY FOR REAL ESTATE TAX EXEMPTIONS TO AGE SIXTY-FIVE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Clause forty-one of section 5 of chapter 59 of the  
2 General Laws, as most recently amended by section 1 of chapter  
3 1069 of the Acts of 1971, is hereby further amended by striking  
4 out in the first sentence wherever appearing, the word "seventy"  
5 and inserting in place thereof the word "sixty-five".

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
