

By Mr. Toomey of Cambridge, petition of Timothy J. Toomey, Jr. (with the approval of the city council) that the Division of Capital Planning and Operations be authorized to convey a certain parcel of land under the control of the Metropolitan District Commission to the city of Cambridge. State Administration. [Local approval received.]

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COMMISSIONER OF CAPITAL PLANNING AND OPERATIONS TO CONVEY TO THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE A CERTAIN PARCEL OF LAND IN SAID CITY UNDER THE CONTROL OF THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The commissioner of capital planning and opera-
2 tions is hereby authorized and directed, in the name of and on
3 behalf of the Commonwealth, to convey to the City of Cambridge,
4 for One Dollar (\$1.00), by deed approved as to form by the
5 Attorney General, a certain parcel of land under the control of the
6 Metropolitan District Commission shown as parcel no. 89 on a
7 plan drawn by Hugh Davis, dated April, 1989, which plan is kept
8 on file with the City Engineer of the City of Cambridge.

9 Said parcel is known and numbered as 24 Monsignor O'Brien
10 Highway.

11 Said conveyance shall be on such terms and conditions as
12 mutually agree upon. Said parcel is park land under the control of
13 the Metropolitan District Commission, provided, however, that
14 said land shall be used by the City of Cambridge for the purpose
15 of enabling said City to establish a Cambridge Heritage Center.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
