

ACTS, 1984. - Chaps. 55, 56.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 46 of chapter 185 of the General Laws, as most recently amended by section 26 of chapter 658 of the acts of 1981, is hereby further amended by adding the following clause:-

Seventh, Liens in favor of the commonwealth for unpaid taxes arising or existing under the laws of the commonwealth.

SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall apply to liens recorded on or after January first, nineteen hundred and eighty-five.

Chap. 55. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PAYMENT OF CERTAIN TAXES.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 60 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

Section 106. Any property tax due a city or town in an amount not in excess of twenty-five dollars shall be due and payable in a single payment when so determined by the appropriating body of such city or town.

SECTION 2. This act shall be applicable with respect to the tax assessment for the year commencing January first, nineteen hundred and eighty-four and for subsequent years.

Chap. 56. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RENT BOARD OF THE TOWN OF BROOKLINE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 843 of the acts of 1970 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "functions", in line 12, the words:- , including the power to establish, amend and charge filing fees and annual unit registration fees subject to the approval of the board of selectmen.
