AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF CONCORD TO GRANT A CERTAIN CONSERVATION RESTRICTION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The board of selectmen and natural resources
2 commission of the town of Concord are hereby authorized to
3 grant a permanent conservation restriction on the following
4 parcels of land:

5 Punkatasset conservation land containing ninety-two acres,
6 more or less, as shown on a plan dated April 23, 1971;

7 Sawmill Brook conservation land containing eight acres, more
8 or less, as shown on a plan dated April 18, 1990;

9 Brewster's Ridge conservation land containing one acre, more
10 or less, as shown on a plan dated May 1, 1990; and

11 Monument Farm conservation land containing fifteen acres,
12 more or less, as shown on a plan dated January 6, 1992 to the
13 Trustees of Reservations, a corporation established by section
14 one of chapter three hundred and fifty-two of the acts of eighteen
15 hundred and ninety-one.

1 SECTION 2. The conservation restriction authorized in section
2 one shall be granted at such time as Harvard University records a
3 notice of public charitable obligation or other charitable intent in
4 a form satisfactory to the board of selectmen of the town of
5 Concord with regard to the land owned by said university known
6 as the Museum of Comparative Zoology Field.
