AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LEASING OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to immediately regulate the leasing
3 of motor vehicles, therefore it is hereby declared to be an emer-
4 gency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the
5 public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:
