2 during the recess of the General Court to make an investigation
3 and study of House document 5467, relative to taxation in the
4 commonwealth.

5 Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of
6 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
7 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
8 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the
9 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
10 December, nineteen hundred and ninety-five.
