AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE EXTENSION OF THE TERM OF AN ACTING TOWN ADMINISTRATOR IN THE TOWN OF EASTHAMPTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 4-3(b) of the charter of the town of
2 Easthampton, which is on file in the Office of the Archivist of the
3 Commonwealth, as provided in section twelve of chapter forty-
4 three B of the General Laws, is hereby amended by adding the
5 following sentence:— The term of acting town administrator may
6 be extended through subsequent three-month extensions by a
7 unanimous vote of the board of selectmen.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
