AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE ADMINISTRATION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES AND THE PERFORMANCE OF CERTAIN MEDICAL PROCEDURES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in
2 the 1994 Official Edition is hereby amended by adding the
3 following subsection: —

4 (h) The commissioner shall not, by regulation or otherwise,
5 pursuant to subsection (g) or any other law, be authorized to reg-
6 ister any unlicensed person to distribute or administer a controlled
7 substance or to perform an invasive procedure. For purposes of
8 this subsection, “invasive procedure” shall mean any procedure or
9 treatment whereby the body is invaded, penetrated or incised,
10 except for phlebotomy.
