3 tion and study of current House document number 6175 relative
4 to extending the deadline for the completion of a study of turnpike
5 ramps.

7 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
8 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
9 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the
10 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
11 December, nineteen hundred and ninety-six.
