3 tion and study of current House document numbered 6189, rela-
4 tive to authorizing the town of Buckland to reimburse certain tax

7 its investigation and study, and its recommendations, if any,
8 together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
9 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the
10 House of Representatives on or before the last Wednesday in
11 December, nineteen hundred and ninety-six.
