AN ACT DESIGNATING A CERTAIN BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF LOWELL AS THE  
LOUIS CENTORE MEMORIAL BRIDGE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The bridge on Hale Street spanning the Boston and Maine rail-
- 2 road tracks in the city of Lowell shall be designated and known as
- 3 the Louis Centore Memorial Bridge in memory of Louis Centore.
- 4 The department of highways shall erect suitable markers thereon
- 5 bearing such designation in compliance with the standards of said
- 6 department.
