AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE USE OF FIREARMS DURING ILLEGAL DRUG ACTIVITY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 3A. Section 18B of Chapter 265 of the General Laws as
2 so appearing is hereby amended by inserting after the words “state
3 prison” in lines 2, 9 and 11 the following: — “, sections 32, 32A,
4 32B, 32C, 32E or 32F of chapter 94C”. Section 3B. Said section
5 18B is hereby further amended by inserting after the word “uses”
6 in line 2 and “used” in line 9 the following words: — “possesses
7 or displays”.
