AN ACT RELATIVE TO VOTER REGISTRATION HOURS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 28 of Chapter 51 of the General Laws, as
2 amended by Chapter 203 of the Acts of 1991, is hereby amended
3 by striking out in line four the words "one thousand" and inserting
4 in place thereof the following words: — fifteen hundred.

1 SECTION 2. Section 29 of Chapter 51 of the General Laws, as
2 appearing in the 1990 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 inserting in line 8 after the word "meetings" the following: — and
4 in towns with a population of 5,000 persons or less.
