AN ACT RELATIVE TO GREYHOUND RACING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any special or general law, rule or regulation,
- 2 to the contrary, the percentages allotted to purse accounts and
- 3 racing meetings licensees for greyhound racing as defined in
- 4 Chapter 128A of the Massachusetts General Laws shall be
- 5 increased by a total of one person.
