### AN ACT REQUIRING COUNSELLING PROGRAM FOR CONVICTED DOMESTIC ABUSERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 3 of Chapter 209A of the General Laws, as appearing
- 2 in the 1992 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in
- 3 line 36, the words "may recommend to the defendant that the
- 4 defendant attend" and inserting in place the following words: —
- 5 shall order the defendant to attend.
