AN ACT PROVIDING FOR COMPENSATION OF CERTAIN COURT OFFICERS OF THE TRIAL COURT OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 46, subsection 12, of chapter 30 of the General Laws,
2 as appearing in the 1988 Official Edition, is hereby amended by
3 striking the period at the end of the first sentence and by adding
4 the following: “, or, in the case of court officers of the trial court
5 of the Commonwealth employed by courts located in the counties
6 of Dukes and Nantucket, in excess of twenty-seven thousand
7 dollars.”
