AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MANDATORY DISPLAY OF INLAND FISH AND GAME LICENSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section twelve of chapter one hundred and thirty-
2 one of the General Laws as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition,
3 is hereby amended in line twenty-two by striking, after the word
4 "person", the words "and wear in a visible manner on his outer
5 clothing".

1 SECTION 2. Section thirty-five of said chapter is repealed.

1 SECTION 3. Section ninety of said chapter is amended in line
2 two by inserting after the word "eleven", the word "twelve", and
3 further amended in line two by striking after the word "thirty-
4 two" the word "thirty-five".

1 SECTION 4. Section six F of chapter twenty-one of the
2 General Laws as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition is hereby
3 amended in line twenty-eight by inserting after the word "eleven",
4 the word "twelve".
