

SENATE. No. 1243

By Mr. Keating, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1243) of William R. Keating and John H. Rogers for legislation to require the operator of a recreational campground to provide certified lifeguards at any pool over the depth of three feet within the aforementioned campground. AN ACT REQUIRING THE OPERATOR OF A RECREATIONAL CAMPGROUND TO PROVIDE CERTIFIED LIFEGUARDS AT ANY POOL OVER THE DEPTH OF THREE FEET WITHIN THE AFOREMENTIONED CAMPGROUND.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 206 of Chapter 140 of the General Laws of
2 Massachusetts is hereby amended by adding the following after
3 the first paragraph: —

4 The operator of a recreational campground, which is an estab-
5 lishment whose main purpose is to attract and accommodate
6 campers and their children on a daily, weekly or monthly basis,
7 shall provide lifeguards at any swimming pool within the afore-
8 mentioned campground with a depth of three or more feet. The
9 lifeguards are to be at least 17 years of age and holding a current
10 Red Cross Advanced Lifesaver's Certificate or the equivalent and
11 a Current American Heart Association or American Red Cross
12 C.P.R. Certificate.
