AN ACT RELATIVE TO SNOW AND ICE ON MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws (1990 Edition) is amended by
2 adding after Section 7CC thereof the following new section: —

3 Section 7DD. No person shall operate a commercial motor
4 vehicle on a public way unless all snow and ice, which may
5 become dislodged and constitute a hazard to other vehicles during
6 operation of said vehicle, has been removed therefrom.

7 Any violation of this section shall be punishable by a fine of
8 not less than a hundred dollars.
