AN ACT RELATIVE TO RETIREMENT CREDIT FOR MEMBERS OF THE DEPARTMENT OF STATE POLICE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 412 of the Acts of 1992, is hereby amended by adding
2 after section 120, the following new section:—
3 Section 120A. Notwithstanding the provisions of sections one
4 hundred and nineteen and one hundred and twenty of this act, or
5 any other general or special law, rule or regulation to the contrary,
6 for the purpose of determining creditable service under the provi-
7 sions of chapter thirty-two of the General Laws, any person
8 serving in a position or employed as an employee exercising
9 police powers in the division of law enforcement of the registry of
10 motor vehicles on the effective date of this act, and who became
11 members of the Department of State Police as a result of the pro-
12 visions of this act, shall be credited with all membership service,
13 prior service and other service for which credit had been estab-
14 lished by said members prior to the passage of this act.
