By Mr. Keating, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1353) of William R. Keating for legislation to provide an additional yearly retirement allowance for state employees who are veterans. Public Service.

AN ACT IMPROVING RETIREMENT BENEFITS FOR VETERANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 5, subsection (2) (b) of Chapter 32 of the General Laws
2 is hereby amended by striking said section and inserting in lieu
3 thereof the following: —

4 (b) Any member of Group 1 or Group 2 or Group 4, who is a
5 veteran as defined in section one, shall receive an additional
6 yearly retirement allowance of thirty dollars for each year of
7 creditable service or fraction thereof; provided, that the total
8 amount of said additional retirement allowance shall not exceed
9 six hundred in any case.
