## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety-Five.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ADJUSTMENT OF PENSION AND RETIREMENT ALLOWANCES OF JUDGES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 65A of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
- 2 the following paragraph: —
- 3 Any judge who has retired and is entitled to receive a pension
- 4 for life at an annual rate equal to three-fourths of the annual rate
- 5 of salary payable at the time of such retirement or a retirement
- 6 allowance to which he may be entitled, if any, under section sixty-
- 7 five A, sixty-five B or sixty-five D, shall receive in addition to his
- 8 annual pension an amount equal to three-fourths of the annual
- 9 rate of salary which would have been payable to him had he con-
- 10 tinued his judicial retirement allowance percent as provided for
- 11 in section sixty-five H.
