AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PENSION RIGHTS OF CALL FIRE FIGHTERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 32 of the Massachusetts General Laws (1990 Edition)
2 is hereby amended by striking in lines 315 through 319 the fol-
3 lowing words: — “; and provided, further, that such service as a
4 permanent-intermittent or call fire fighter shall be credited only if
5 such permanent-intermittent or call fire fighter was later
6 appointed as a permanent member of the fire department.”
