AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MASSACHUSETTS  
PORT AUTHORITY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 2 of Chapter 465 of the Acts of 1956, is hereby amended
- 2 by adding in the second sentence of the second paragraph after the
- 3 words "and shall include" the following:— at least one member
- 4 who resides in one of the following towns: Concord, Lincoln,
- 5 Lexington or Bedford.
