AN ACT FURTHER DEFINING MASS TRANSIT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 19 of Chapter 6A of the Massachusetts General Laws
2 as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition is hereby amended by
3 inserting at the end thereof the following:

4 Notwithstanding any special or general law to the contrary for
5 agencies within the Executive Office of Transportation and
6 Construction mass transit shall be construed to mean providing
7 transportation services to the general public including human
8 service agency clients; and provided further in order to provide
9 transportation of human services agency clients in the most
10 efficient manner, contracts for services between RTAs and the
11 state for human service agency clients transportation beyond the
12 territorial boundaries authorized for said RTA in section 2 of
13 Chapter 161B are hereby authorized.
