RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF WILFRED WANNAMAHER.

1 *Resolved.* That for the purpose of discharging a moral obliga-
2 tion, and notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special
3 law to the contrary, the commonwealth is hereby authorized and
4 directed to pay to Wilfred Wannamaker of Dalton, a sum not to
5 exceed eight thousand three hundred and four dollars and ninety-
6 eight cents, the amount which said Wilfred Wannamaker was
7 ordered by a court to pay to the department of employment and
8 training as contributions under the provisions of chapter one hun-
9 dred and fifty-one A of the General Laws. Said Wilfred Wanna-
10 maker, a disabled person, required a personal care attendant from
11 January first, nineteen hundred and ninety-one to December
12 thirty-first, nineteen hundred and ninety-two, for which contribu-
13 tions were required under said chapter one hundred and fifty-one
14 A but were not paid.
