AN ACT RELATIVE TO VETERANS' LICENSE PLATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The seventh paragraph of section 2 of chapter 90 of the
2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1992 Official Edition, is
3 hereby amended by inserting after the third sentence the fol-
4 lowing sentence:— The registrar of motor vehicles may issue,
5 without charge, to former prisoners of war, as so defined, who
6 were also awarded the Order of the Purple Heart, upon presenta-
7 tion of satisfactory evidence of such prisoner of war and purple
8 heart award status, as determined by the registrar, distinctive reg-
9 istration plates for one pleasure passenger vehicle owned and
10 principally used by said individual.
