“An Act authorizing the city of Worcester to permit the simultaneous holding of certain alcoholic beverage licenses.

1 Notwithstanding the provisions of sections twelve, nineteen, or
2 nineteen C of chapter one hundred and thirty-eight of the General
3 Laws or any other general or special law to the contrary, the Main
4 Street Brewing Co., Ltd., a Massachusetts Corporation, which
5 holds a license pursuant to the provisions of said section nineteen
6 or said section nineteen C, may also hold an all alcoholic beverage
7 license pursuant to the provisions of said section twelve or may
8 hold any license pursuant to the provisions of said section twelve
9 to sell at retail to consumers any malt beverage or malt beverage
10 product.
