AN ACT PROVIDING FOR LIVE-IN PERSONNEL AT PUBLIC ELDERLY HOUSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 23B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 1994
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following
3 section:—
4 Section 29. The department is hereby authorized and directed to
5 promulgate rules and regulations relative to allowing personnel to
6 live in public elderly housing under the control of the secretary of
7 communities and development. Such personnel shall be respon-
8 sible for overseeing the safety and well-being of elderly residents
9 of public housing. Persons who are charged with said responsibili-
10 ties shall be given an apartment in public housing for a reduced
11 rate and a stipend as determined by the department.
