AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEMORIAL DAY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 136, section 16 of the General Laws, as  
2 so appearing in the 1994 Official Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 striking out, in line 2, the words "Memorial Day,".

1 SECTION 2. Said section 16 of said chapter 136, as so  
2 appearing, is hereby further amended by striking out, in lines 14  
3 and 15, the words "Memorial Day;".
