AN ACT ESTABLISHING A SICK LEAVE BANK FOR DOREEN A. ANDREWS,
AN EMPLOYEE OF THE TRIAL COURT.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would tend to
2 defeat its purpose, which is to establish a sick leave bank for a
3 certain employee of the trial court of the commonwealth, there-
4 fore it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for
5 the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding the provision of any general or special law,
2 rule or regulation to the contrary, the trial court is hereby autho-
3 rized and directed to establish a sick leave bank for Doreen A.
4 Andrews, an employee of the Plymouth Division of the District
5 Court department of the trial court. Any employee of the
6 Plymouth Division of the District Court may voluntarily con-
7 tribute one or more of his sick, personal or vacation days to said
8 sick leave bank for use by said Doreen A. Andrews. Said leave
9 shall be administered by the Clerk-Magistrate of the Plymouth
10 Division of District Court.
