AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE APPOINTMENT OF JOSEPH JACKSON, JR.  
AND THOMAS F. BAMBERY, JR. TO THE FIRE DEPARTMENT OF THE CITY  
OF QUINCY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 26 of  
2 chapter 31 of General Laws or any other general or special law to  
3 the contrary, Joseph Jackson, Jr., so long as he passes the required  
4 written and physical examinations for entrance to the fire service,  
5 shall have his name certified for original appointment to the fire  
6 department of the city of Quincy before all others in the eligible  
7 list for such appointment.

1 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 26 of  
2 chapter 31 of the General Laws or any other general or special law  
3 to the contrary, Thomas F. Bambery, Jr., so long as he passes the  
4 required written and physical examinations for entrance to the fire  
5 service, shall have his name certified for original appointment to  
6 the fire department of the city of Quincy before all others in the  
7 eligible list for such appointment.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
