AN ACT RELATIVE TO PUBLIC HEALTH.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Massachusetts General Laws, Chapter 111,
2 Section 31 is hereby amended by adding to the second paragraph
3 the following:
4 “and no code, rule, regulation, or standard shall take effect until
5 so filed.”

1 SECTION 2. A code, rule, regulation or standard adopted by a
2 board of health before the effective date of this act, and required
3 to be filed with the department of environmental protection by
4 section 31 of chapter 111 of the General Laws, shall cease to be
5 effective upon the effective date of this act until it has been so
6 filed.
