AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE SURCHARGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

4 inspection; by inserting after the word "plate", in line 219, the

7 and by inserting after the word "plate," in line 221, the following
8 words: — or windshield.
