AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LEASING OF CERTAIN PROPERTY BY THE TOWNS OF GROVELAND, MERRIMAC AND WEST NEWBURY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The towns of Groveland, Merrimac, and West Newbury are
2 hereby authorized to lease land and buildings to the Pentucket
3 Regional School District for any new or existing elementary
4 school. Such lease shall be for a term not exceeding fifty years
5 and shall be authorized, executed and delivered on behalf of the
6 town by its board of selectmen and by said school district by
7 the regional district school committee. Such lease may provide,
8 without limitation that it shall terminate and the leased property
9 shall revert to the town if the town should no longer be a member
10 of the regional school district or if the regional school district
11 school committee should determine that the land, with the
12 building and other improvements thereon, is no longer needed for
13 the educational program of said school district.
