AN ACT RELATIVE TO VOLUNTEER, NON-PROFIT FIRE DEPARTMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 48, section 44A as appearing in the 1994 Official
2 Edition, is hereby amended in line one and replaced with the
3 following: — No city, town or authority shall contract with any
4 private, commercial, for-profit fire fighting unit to operate within
5 said city, town or authority unless said unit has been certified by
6 the department of public safety.
