AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE MWRA RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law, rule, or regulation
2 to the contrary, the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority
3 Retirement System Board is hereby authorized to grant creditable
4 service to a present employee who is a member of said retirement
5 system who served as an employee of the United States House of
6 Representatives and who has completed ten or more years of
7 membership service; provided, however, such creditable service
8 shall be determined by said board; further provided that such
9 creditable service shall not be credited until such member has paid
10 into the Massachusetts Water Resources Authority Retirement
11 System, in one sum or in installments, upon such terms and condi-
12 tions as said Retirement Board may prescribe make-up payments
13 equal to the payments made by the member while in the employ-
14 ment of the United States House of Representatives, plus the
15 accrued interest on said payments.
