AN ACT RELATIVE TO OPTIONS ON RETIREMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 2 General Laws, as appearing in the 1996 Official Edition, is hereby
- 3 amended by striking out, in line 21, the word "effective." and
- 4 inserting in place thereof the following words:— effective,
- 5 provided further, however, that a member retired for disability
- 6 under the provisions of section six, section seven, or who is
- 7 retired under the provisions of subdivision (2) of section twenty-
- 8 six may change his election by making a new election if the
- 9 member has delayed acceptance of his allowance.
- 1 SECTION 2. This Act shall apply to all members retired for
- 2 disability on or after January 1, 1970.
