AN ACT RELATIVE TO DISABLED AMERICAN VETERANS' LAND IN BARNSTABLE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 1 of chapter 554 of the acts of 1983 is
2 hereby amended by striking out after “in the town of Barnstable”
3 the words “upon which a veterans post is to be built;” and
4 inserting in place thereof the following words:— which may be
5 used for any lawful purpose.

1 SECTION 2. The commissioner of the division of capital asset
2 management and maintenance may record an instrument with the
3 appropriate registry of deeds that releases the restriction requiring
4 the property to be used for purposes of a veterans' post in the deed
5 recorded under the authority of section 1 of chapter 554 of the
6 acts of 1983.
