AN ACT PLACING CERTAIN CORRECTIONAL EMPLOYEES IN GROUP FOUR OF THE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Group 4 paragraph (g) of subdivision 2 of section 3 of chapter
2 32, amended by section (1) of chapter 71 of the acts of 1996, is
3 hereby amended, by inserting after the words “supervising prison
4 camp officer,” the following words:— correctional program
5 officer I, II, III.
