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### AN ACT ESTABLISHING A GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE DEVELOPMENT AND UPDATING OF SCHOOL CURRICULUMS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section One E of Chapter Sixty-Nine of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 1996 Official Edition, is hereby amended by  
3 adding the following at the end thereof:—  
4 Subject to appropriation, the board shall establish a grant pro-  
5 gram which shall award annual grants to any school district for  
6 the costs associated with the development, evaluation, updating or  
7 refining of curricula, textbooks, technology and other instructional  
8 materials. Such grant shall be provided to an eligible school dis-  
9 trict on an annual basis for a three year period, provided that such  
10 school district shall thereafter be ineligible to receive funds autho-  
11 rized under this program for a period of seven years. The board  
12 shall promulgate regulations relative to the implementation of this  
13 program.
