AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE LICENSURE AND TRAINING OF NURSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Notwithstanding any provision of Chapter 71 of the Acts of 1993,
2 or regulations promulgated pursuant thereto, any school nurse who
3 is hired on or before October 1, 1999, who is not hired as a health
4 teacher or who is not otherwise employed as a teacher in an elemen-
5 tary or secondary school in the commonwealth, shall not be required
6 to pass an examination covering communication and literacy skills
7 in order to work as, or to continue to work as, a school nurse.
