Walsh for legislation to require the Department of Housing and Community Development to offer the elderly multiple placement options in public housing. Housing and Urban Development.

AN ACT REQUIRING THE DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO OFFER THE ELDERLY THE OPTION OF ONE OF THREE PLACEMENTS IN PUBLIC HOUSING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 40 of Chapter 121B of the General Laws is hereby
2 amended by inserting after subsection (g), as amended by
3 section 12 of section 179 of the Acts of 1995, the following sub-
4 section:—

5 (i) When selecting elderly persons as tenants, the department
6 shall offer to elderly persons at least three units, which units shall
7 not be located in the same housing project or development, from
8 which such elderly person shall choose one.
