AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING THE ADMISSIBILITY OF JUVENILE DELINQUENCY ADJUDICATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 60 of chapter 119 of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 1996 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 word "person", in line 8, the following words:—, including the
- 4 use of prior adjudications of delinquency by the court in sen-
- 5 tencing a defendant on a criminal matter.
