AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE PENSION BENEFITS PAYABLE TO LEO J. MARTIN  
BY THE STATE RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, for  
2 the purpose of determining the retirement allowance to be paid to  
3 Mr. Leo J. Martin, a retired captain of the State Police, said retire-  
4 ment allowance shall be calculated on the basis of what his  
5 average base salary would have been for the twelve month period  
6 immediately prior to retirement pursuant to Section 108L of  
7 Chapter 41, M.G.L., as inserted by Chapter 835 of the Acts of  
8 1970, had appropriation been made for the purpose thereof; pro-  
9 vided, however, that Mr. Martin shall deposit into the state pen-  
10 sion retirement system an amount equal to the difference between  
11 what his contribution would have been had his base salary been so  
12 calculated, and his actual contributions for the period from  
13 November 28, 1970 until his date of retirement.
