AN ACT FURTHER REGULATING PENSIONS OF POLICE AND FIRE DISPATCHERS AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in
- 2 the 1998 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the
- 3 words "assistant fire control men," in line 305, the following
- 4 words:— "an employee of a police or fire department who is
- 5 employed as a civilian dispatcher or telecommunicator of fire and
- 6 police or emergency medical services,".
