

ACTS, 1984. - Chaps. 162, 163.

Station 16+00± to thirty-five (35±) feet wide at Station 16+78±, being thirty-five (35±) feet wide from Station 16+78± to Station 17+10±, and tapering from thirty-five (35±) feet wide at Station 17+10± to a point on the Easterly Layout Line at Station 17+25±. The herein described Parcel 10 contains about twenty thousand (20,000±) square feet more or less and overlaps the Drainage Easement Parcel 5.

PARCEL 11 - (West Side) - Slope Easement

A strip of land running four hundred and forty-five (445±) feet more or less along the Proposed Westerly Layout Line of Water Street between Station 12+85± and Station 17+30± of the proposed Water Street Baseline, beginning at a point that is fifty (50±) feet west of said Westerly Layout Line at Station 12+85± and widening to fifty (50±) feet (and meeting said Layout Line) at Station 13+15±, being fifty (50±) feet wide from Station 13+15± to Station 16+05±, widening along the arc of a curve (radius=80'±, angle=88°-30'± from fifty (50±) feet at Station 16+05± to one hundred and twenty-five (125±) feet at Station 16+70±, being one hundred and twenty-five (125±) feet wide from Station 16+70± to Station 17+20±, and being ninety-two (92±) feet wide from Station 17+20± to Station 17+30±).

The herein described Parcel 11 contains about twenty-nine thousand, five hundred (29,500±) square feet more or less and overlaps Drainage Easement Parcel 6A and 6B and Parcel 9 (a part of the Old Water Street Layout which is not part of the Proposed Layout).

Chap. 162. AN ACT DIRECTING THE BROCKTON POLICE RELIEF ASSOCIATION TO MAKE CERTAIN ADDITIONAL PAYMENTS.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:

Notwithstanding the provisions of any general or special law to the contrary, the Brockton Police Relief Association is hereby authorized and directed to pay to any member in good standing, upon the death of his spouse, the sum of five hundred dollars.

Chap. 163. AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE ELECTION OF SCHOOL COMMITTEE MEMBERS IN THE CITY OF MELROSE.

Be it enacted, etc., as follows:
