AN ACT GRANTING RETIREMENT SERVICE CREDIT FOR A CERTAIN RETIREE
OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation to the contrary, the
- 2 state retirement board shall allow William Thibault, a former
- 3 employee of the Massachusetts Department of Revenue to purchase
- 4 retirement service credit for the time in which he served as a
- 5 Selectman in the town of Blackstone, 1988-1991 inclusive.
